October Meeting

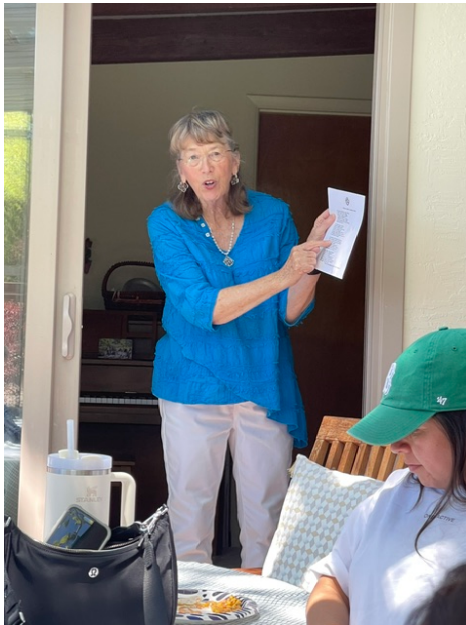
